Ensuring appropriate documentation is completed on delivery to customers, uplift of site debris and disposal of debris within Darnick Street waste area, daily vehicle checks are carried out in conjunction with CB procedures.

You will be enthusiastic about customer service and will be Health and Safety conscious.
